## BAPIO Mentorship Scheme Overview January 2025

The BAPIO Mentorship Scheme aims to provide senior-led (Consultant / GP Partner / Senior Registrar) guidance and advice to resident and LED doctors who are part of BAPIO's Young Doctors Forum.

Specifically, the BAPIO Mentorship Scheme would aim to:

#### 1. Provide Speciality-Specific Support to Resident/LED Doctors

Several resident doctors in the UK do not have a designated educational supervisor. The absence of such supervision significantly hinders their ability to work on their portfolio and to demonstrate commitment to their speciality. The pastoral support and guidance from BAPIO Mentors would be much-needed support for such resident doctors.

#### 2. Give BAPIO Mentees the Chance to be Involved in Ongoing Projects

As you will be aware, the recent updates in the speciality applications demand significant portfolio building, increasing the pressure on doctors to complete quality improvement projects(QIPs), presentations, publications etc. If BAPIO Mentors have any ongoing projects which would benefit from additional support, we would encourage them to consider involving BAPIO Mentees in these projects.

#### 3. Increase awareness of BAPIO's activities and groups
